Introduction

The Asia Sunday in 2017 will be observed on Sunday 15 October.

The Christian Conference of Asia (CCA) observes the Asia Sunday every year on the Sunday before the Pentecost. It was proposed that the Asia Sunday in 2017 be observed on 15 October 2017 as part of the commemoration of the Diamond Jubilee of CCA which will be held in conjunction with the Asia Mission Conference (AMC) scheduled to take place from 11 to 17 October 2017 in Yangon, Myanmar.

The theme of the Asia Sunday -2017 will be the same theme as that of the AMC, 'Journeying Together: 'Prophetic Witness to the Truth and Light, in Asia'.

The significance of this theme is that, it is linked to the role and relevance of the CCA in the Asian context, especially when it celebrates its journey of 60 years. As this theme resonates with the contemporary realities in Asia it will be helpful for Asian churches to reflect on the mission and prophetic witness of Asian churches in the midst of many adverse realities, and to emphasise the hope and trust in God's promises for all God's people in Asia.

More than 600 representatives of churches, ecumenical councils and related organisations from Asia and around the world will gather in Yangon, Myanmar for the AMC and more than 6000 representatives of Myanmar churches will come together in the afternoon of Sunday 15 October 2017 in Yangon to attend a thanksgiving service and commemoration of the Diamond Jubilee of CCA. It is a time for celebrating the journeying together of the Asian churches and all members of the wider ecumenical family and fellowships. On this special occasion of the 60th anniversary of CCA, we request all member churches, councils and related ecumenical organisations to observe the Asia Sunday in a befitting manner on Sunday 15 October or another Sunday before the end of 2017, according to the convenience of each member church or council.

We request all member churches and councils of the CCA to offer special prayers and give thanks to the God almighty as CCA enters into a new era of journeying together as an instrument of God, working on behalf of Asian churches.



O Lord, Please Have Mercy on Us














Pardon



So we may witness the Gospel, serve your people and heal the whole creation.


